1. SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

Submit your file electronically, by **February 22, 2017**, at http://www.systor.org/2017/cfp.html. Your submission should include two files:

- An extended abstract following the formatting guidelines detailed below.
- A draft poster (formatted for A4) in PDF.

Formatting:

- Extended abstracts may be at most 1 page long, including references.
- Please use this latex template for submission as well as the camera ready version. The template complies with the SYSTOR typesetting guidelines.
- The title of every poster abstract **must** start with "POSTER:".
- Categories and subject descriptors are required for the camera-ready version only. You can choose not to include them in your submission.
- Make sure all fonts are embedded in the resulting PDF file
- Use a *number* citation format as following [1, 3, 2].
- Make sure to include the names of all authors along with their affiliation and email ID.
- Please refer to the sample author block in this document.

- The finalized PDF of your extended abstract should be labeled as SYSTOR17_"Lead Author".pdf, and submitted by email, following the instructions at http://www.systor.org/2017/cfp.html.
- The deadline for submitting the final extended abstract and ACM electronic copyright forms is 11:59pm Pacific Daylight Time (PDT) April 26, 2017.
