## CAMERA-READY SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

Please follow these guidelines:

1. ACM guidelines regarding fonts should be followed

http://www.acm.org/publications/gi-proceedings part 6e

"[Papers] should have Type 1 fonts (scalable), not Type 3 (bit-mapped).

All fonts MUST be embedded within the PDF file."

- Authors should make sure to use the ACM classification system. For details see <a href="https://dl.acm.org/ccs/ccs.cfm">https://dl.acm.org/ccs/ccs.cfm</a> and instructions in the .tex file.
- 3. Papers should NOT include page numbers in the final manuscript
- 4. Be sure that there are no bad page or column breaks, meaning no widows (last line of a paragraph at the top of a column). Section and Sub-section heads should remain with at least 2 lines of body text when near the end of a page or column.
- 5. Make sure you use the ACM assigned DOI for your paper.

When authors submit their eRights forms they receive confirmation messages that include the appropriate "copyright" text & DOI for their papers.
