





## **CAMERA-READY SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS**

## Additionally, please follow these guidelines:

- ACM guidelines regarding fonts should be followed:
   <a href="http://www.acm.org/publications/gi-proceedings">http://www.acm.org/publications/gi-proceedings</a> part 6e:
   "[Papers] should have Type 1 fonts (scalable), not Type 3 (bit-mapped). All fonts MUST be embedded within the PDF file."
- 2. Authors should make sure to use the ACM classification system. For details see: https://dl.acm.org/ccs/ccs.cfm and instructions in the .tex file.
- 3. Papers should NOT include page numbers in the final manuscript
- 4. Be sure that there are no bad page or column breaks, meaning no widows (last line of a paragraph at the top of a column).
- 5. Section and Sub-section heads should remain with at least 2 lines of body text when near the end of a page or column.
- 6. Remember to omit the "anonymous" tag from the \document class
- 7. Make sure you use the ACM assigned DOI and ISBN for your paper. When authors submit their eRights forms they receive confirmation messages that include the appropriate "copyright" text, DOI and ISBN for their papers. The camera-ready version should include the updated ACM copyright text.

The deadline for submitting the final paper and ACM electronic copyright forms is 11:59pm (AOE) May 18, 2020
